This is an educational program meant to be the primary educational resource for laboratory medicine trainees worldwide. The CCTC has broadened its valuable content to include lectures and educational materials in all disciplines of laboratory medicine including microbiology, transfusion medicine, molecular diagnostics and hematology.

The CCTC includes an abundance of free educational materials including the recently launched Question Bank. The Question Bank assists laboratory medicine trainees in preparation for board examinations in both the US and UK and helps those wishing to assess their knowledge. Tailor your study experience to your personal needs. With over 3,000 questions available on the program or under peer review, it is an ever-evolving program that keeps users returning daily. Other valuable content includes Clinical Case Studies, Q&A (a virtual roundtable discussion among a group of experts about a hot topic), and the Guide to Scientific Writing (a series of 14 articles). In addition, the journal periodically publishes interviews with world scientific leaders and articles about prominent clinical chemists (Inspiring Minds) that can be of great interest and serve as an inspiration to young scientists. The timely Pearls of Laboratory Medicine are 15 minute presentations about key topic, and CouncilChat is a chat room directed by 6 junior faculty members from around the world. In addition, as members of the CCTC, all trainees have access to our more than 200 popular podcasts, which have been downloaded over 820,000 times in the last 3 years.
