The C-CC has responsibility for a range of activities related to congresses, conferences and scientific meetings. These responsibilities include:

- Oversight of the biennial International Congress of Clinical Chemistry and Laboratory Medicine;
- Oversight of the biennial EuroMedLab Congress of Clinical Chemistry and Laboratory Medicine
- Oversight of the four Regional Congresses of Clinical Chemistry and Laboratory Medicine;
- Oversight of the IFCC General Conference
- Membership of the organising committee of some of the IFCC Specialised Conferences;
- Provision of advice on how to organise a conference;
- Granting of IFCC auspices for conferences in the field of laboratory medicine.
